Start/finish – Located at Main Street and Depot Street (230 W Main Street Ionia, MI)

Parking– available at Depot and Adams (233 Adams Street Ionia, MI). DO NOT park in western most lot near dog park, this is a private lot and may result in vehicles being towed. **Handcyclist parking ONLY on Depot Street between Main Street and Adams Street (approximate address 116 S Depot Street)**

Registration and portable restrooms – Located on Depot Street, south of the start/finish. Approximate address is 109 S Depot Street.

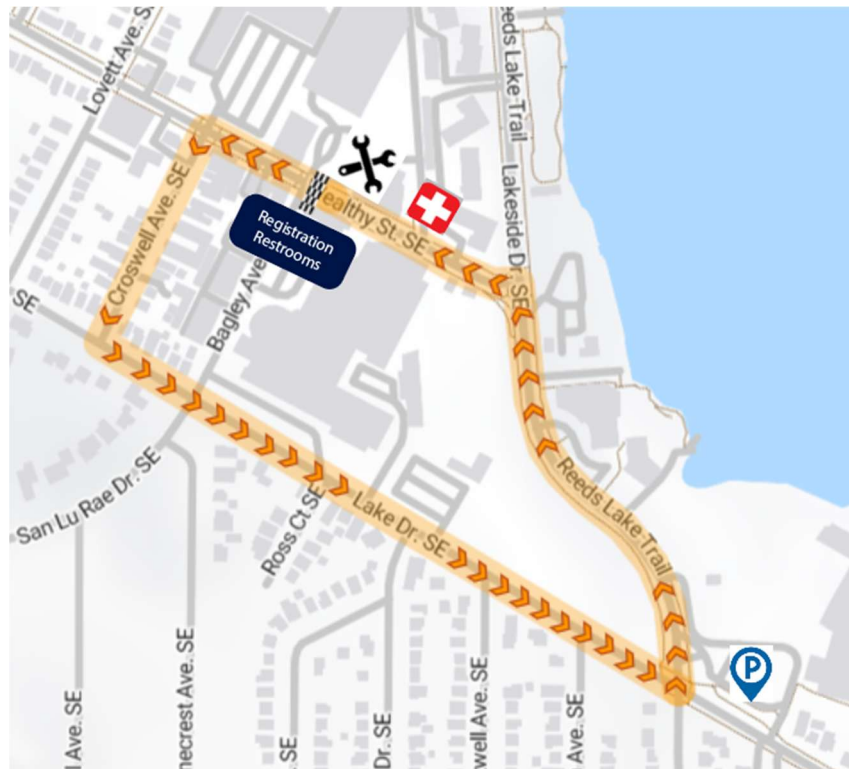

Start/finish – Located at Wealthy Street and Bagley Avenue (2237 Wealthy St SE Grand Rapids, MI)

Parking – East Grand Rapids Middle School (2425 Lake Dr SE, East Grand Rapids, MI)
– OR – Remington Park (2310 Reeds Lake Blvd SE, East Grand Rapids, MI)

Handcyclist parking ONLY in Bagley Avenue lot inside the course. Crossing the course at San Lu Rae Drive when allowed by course marshal. (approximate address for parking is 727 Bagley Avenue)

Registration and Portable Restrooms – Located inside of the course near the Start/Finish at approximately 701 Bagley Avenue SE

Racing Information

Registration – Pre-registration will close online on Wednesday July 29th at 8:00 pm ET. “Day-of” registration will re-open Friday July 31st at 3:00 pm ET and will remain open for each race until 30 minutes prior to the start of the race. All registration, including onsite registration will be ONLINE ONLY through [BikeReg](#), there will be no cash option onsite.

Race Numbers – Registration will open one hour prior to the first race each day. You must show valid USA Cycling license at time of number pickup. If racing both Ionia Grand Prix and East Grand Rapids Gaslight Criterium, assigned numbers are the for both days, this also applies if racing multiple fields. If you have received your number in Ionia, you do not need to check in at registration in East Grand Rapids

Racers will be issued one number and will be **worn on the right side both days**. Numbers are not to be obscured by hair, vests, or other coverings. Numbers must not be cut or altered and doing so may result in a fine. A guide for number placement can be found [here](#).



Primes will be regularly awarded during each race. Primes are to be collected immediately after each race from the stage area. Riders do not need to complete the race to claim primes. Primes may be in cash or product.

Free Laps may be granted for “recognized” mishaps, according to USA Cycling Regulations. Free laps end at the number of laps determined by the USAC officials.

Neutral Support will be available on a limited basis. You are encouraged to bring your own wheels for “wheels in/wheels out.” Your wheels should be tagged with your information.

Neutral Support services will be provided by Biked, and they will address mechanical issues and flats to the best of their ability. Mechanics will work under the supervision and direction of a USAC referee who will determine free laps and timing. Riders suffering a mishap must make it to the neutral service pit under their own power. Riders may cut the course, but may not travel backwards on the course.

Neutral support location will be near the start finish. Riders will stage for reentry on the course under the direction of a USAC official.

Medical Support will be available, locations for each day are located on the course maps.

Podium Presentations – Race Podiums will take place 15 minutes after the finish of each race for the top three racers in each category in the field. The sequence of the podiums for each day will be as follows:

Ionia Grand Prix

1. Race Podium – Top three finishers in each category in the field
2. Grand River Shootout Omnium Leader
3. Midwest Cup Omnium Leader

Gaslight Criterium

1. Race Podium – Top three finishers in each category in the field
2. Grand River Shootout Omnium – Top three finishers in the category
3. Midwest Cup Omnium – Top three finishers in the series

Grand River Shootout Omnium

Omniums will be offered based on categories listed below. Points will be awarded at the final sprint of each race following 25/20/17/15/13/11/9/8/7/6/5/4/3/2/1 to the top 15 racers. Additionally, Mid Race Sprints will be awarded to top 3 for 10/6/4 points. Omnium will be based off total points and ties will be determined by place at the Gaslight Criterium.

Omnium Leaders after the first day will be provided a Race Leaders number the MUST be worn day 2. This number will be placed on the left side, opposite side as the race number.

Plaques will be awarded to the top three (3) in each of the categories at the completion of the omnium.

Racers DO NOT need to race both days to be eligible for the overall omnium standings.
